As Chief Financial Officer (CFO) of UPMC in North Central Pa., I visit our UPMC locations, departments, clinics, and offices frequently. It is important that I am out in the field, seeing what goes on and meeting both the people who work here and those who use our services. I learn a lot and get a chance to show my personal support. This helps me make better financial decisions.

I am proud to be a part of UPMC and see firsthand how Susquehanna Health Foundation and its donors are invaluable assets to our organization's financial stability, reputation, operational efficiency, and the ability to achieve our mission. As a nonprofit, building strong, transparent, and mutually beneficial relationships with stakeholders is an imperative. We are incredibly fortunate to have a strong partnership with the Foundation.

The impact of financial contributions extends in ways that might not be obvious to the casual observer, such as:

- Operating Capital & Growth: Grants and donations offset the costs of special projects and expanding needed services.
- **Reserve Building:** Providing a financial cushion during unexpected economic downturns or other types of emergencies is important. The consistent support from our donors allows UPMC to build and maintain adequate reserve funds so that we remain ready to serve the community.
- Improved Cash Flow: Grants and donations help ensure we meet our financial obligations as a health network and also invest in the future.
- Enhanced Programs: Collaborating with donors leads to new and innovative programs and initiatives that can boost our impact and reach within the community.

Much of our outreach comes from grassroots efforts. UPMC deeply values our local board and donor relationships. We often connect through word-of-mouth, which improves fundraising by letting us collaborate directly with donors who want to help. We strive to maintain open communication and transparency with our stakeholders. I am a firm believer in the saying, "When you know better, you do better."

Recent financial indicators show how knowing better has enabled us to do better. For starters, our operating financials remain positive in 2025, following a post-pandemic financial turnaround that took about two years. In addition, a few major capital projects

- Interventional radiology upgrade and relocation
- · Clinical laboratory upgrades and remodeling
- Two MRI upgrades/replacements
- Two CT scanner upgrades
- Expansion of cardiology services in Wellsboro
- Remodeling of the inpatient rehabilitation units
- Cardiovascular gym expansion and remodeling
- Replacement of dietary coolers and dishwashers
- Electrical system improvements
- Elevator improvements
- Roof replacements

As we head into the final months of the year, we continue to stay focused on reducing waste, streamlining processes, and improving efficiency across the organization. We remain focused on optimizing our revenue cycle through enhanced billing accuracy, fewer claim denials, and shorter reimbursement cycles. Negotiating reasonable reimbursement rates with our payers lets us utilize value-based care models focused on improved patient outcomes.

In terms of investments, we continue to focus on important technologies, such as electronic health records (EHR) systems. On September 27, our hospitals and clinics successfully transitioned to EPIC, UPMC's new centralized EHR system. This marks the first wave of a system-wide rollout, streamlining patient care and uniting all UPMC facilities under one powerful platform. Using this technology will allow for faster, more secure digital record keeping and sharing among a patient's medical care teams, and it

will improve patient care and outcomes throughout our 12-county service area. We also are focusing on Al-driven predictive analytics and cybersecurity measures. Since we service rural communities, it is important to embrace and leverage digital tools, such as telemedicine and remote monitoring, so that we can expand care delivery, improve efficiency, and reduce costs.

It is also important for UPMC to meet the modern challenges of workforce management and sustainability. To prevent staffing shortages and burnout, we are using smart strategies that attract and retain health care workers. These [strategies] include competitive compensation and benefits, flexible scheduling options, and desirable training and professional development opportunities. They also include anticipating future workforce needs, exploring alternative staffing models, and developing talent pipelines with our local educational institutions.

From a CFO's perspective, the challenges in health care are numerous. Rising costs, workforce shortages, regulatory complexities, and evolving reimbursement models are just a few examples. I am grateful for all the donors who continue to support our work, our workforce, and our mission. Like the quilts our volunteers make for every Gatehouse patient (you can read about them in the "Your Contributions at Work" story), our generous donors come together to form a steadfast patchwork of financial support and security for our patients, employees, and community. It's a testament to the generosity and loving spirit that make our region an amazing place to live.

Radiation Oncology

A Million-Dollar Mission: Advancing Cancer Treatment in North Central Pennsylvania

Inside the Radiation Oncology suite at UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Williamsport, cutting-edge technology meets compassionate care. From lifesaving treatments to innovative radiation therapy techniques, discover how a small city is making a big impact in the fight against cancer. Plus, learn how a new linear accelerator could transform outcomes for patients across north central Pennsylvania.



illiamsport, Pennsylvania — birthplace of Little League Baseball and a haven for Victorian architecture — is also the medical hub of rural north central Pennsylvania. Founded in 1866, the city boasts a rich history. Though far from the urban centers of Pittsburgh and Philadelphia, Williamsport offers patients access to some of the most advanced radiation oncology techniques and technologies, thanks to UPMC Hillman Cancer Center's services at the UPMC Williamsport Divine Providence Campus.

UPMC Hillman Cancer Center's Radiation Oncology Department: A Beacon of Hope

Radiation therapy, also known as radiotherapy, uses x-rays or other high-energy types of radiation to destroy cancer cells and shrink tumors — often making surgery or chemotherapy more effective. According to the National Library of Medicine, about 50% of people with cancer receive some form of radiation during their treatment.

At UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Williamsport, a skilled team delivers radiation therapy to approximately 30 patients daily from across a 14-county region. In 2024 alone, the cancer center administered nearly 8,000 treatments to 675 new patients and 214 returning patients.

The Power of Partnership: One Patient's Story

Deborah Helm is a two-time cancer survivor. In 2017, she was diagnosed with squamous cell rectal cancer, which was successfully treated with radiation and chemotherapy. After seven cancer-free years, Deborah learned the devastating news that she had developed breast cancer. A mammogram was followed by a biopsy, and an aggressive tumor was found in her left breast. "It can't be happening again," she thought. "Not again."

A true fighter, Deborah didn't hesitate to begin cancer treatment. This time, her treatment included chemotherapy, lumpectomy, and radiation at UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Williamsport. Only there was a new challenge. At 78, holding her breath and staying still long enough for the radiation treatment was nearly impossible, even though it was critically necessary.



Deborah's care team introduced a continuous positive airway pressure (CPAP) device to control her breathing during her treatment. This would allow them to target the cancer with minimal radiation exposure to her healthy tissue, including her heart.

At first Deborah and her husband were skeptical and concerned about using the device. "We thought, 'Wasn't that the machine with the mask for people with sleep apnea?" she recalls. After the benefits were explained to them, however, she agreed to try it out.

"It worked like a charm," Deborah says. "With a CPAP, I could remain still the whole time. I used it for all my 20 radiation treatments."

"Using a CPAP device with radiation therapy is a way to protect the heart while we use radiation on another organ," says **David Cousins, M.D.**, radiation oncologist. The device helps patients hold still longer during the treatment, allowing medical staff to carefully target tumors while sparing the healthy surrounding tissue. While common in Europe, this technique is still emerging in the United States.

Reflecting on her experience, Deborah shares, "People are scared to death when they have cancer. Every treatment session is a reminder of what they're battling. The wonderful radiation oncology team at UPMC is always so kind and supportive, and that's a lifeline to their patients — exactly when they need it most."



Investing in Tomorrow's Treatments

To continue delivering cutting-edge care, Susquehanna Health Foundation is raising **\$1 million** to help fund a new **Varian TrueBeam linear accelerator** for the Radiation Oncology Department at UPMC Hillman Cancer Center in Williamsport. The total cost of this state-of-the-art equipment is \$6.5 million.

This upgrade will ensure patients in north central Pennsylvania have access to the most advanced technology — on par with major metropolitan hospitals and leading academic medical centers. The TrueBeam system will enhance treatment precision and effectiveness, leading to improved patient outcomes. **Donor support is vital to making this upgrade possible.**

Faster, More Precise Treatment

The TrueBeam system delivers radiation at higher dose rates, meaning shorter treatment times and less time on the table. This reduces the chance of patient movement, which offers several benefits:

- Tumors can be targeted more accurately, sparing healthy tissue.
- Less repeat imaging is needed to realign the patient.
- Appointments are shorter and more efficient.

Its automated process also streamlines work flow, eliminating the need for therapists to re-enter the room once the patient is positioned.

With stereotactic body radiation therapy and stereotactic radiosurgery capabilities, the TrueBeam system will deliver pinpoint-accurate, image-guided treatment in a fraction of the time required by conventional methods. Treatments that once required 20 to 45 sessions can now often be completed in as few as five — or even one.

This technology is especially effective for treating hard-to-reach tumors in the brain, lungs, head and neck, and other areas of the body.

- Integrated Gated RapidArc radiotherapy, which monitors breathing during treatment and compensates for tumor motion.

Her journey also highlights the importance of early detection. Deborah's breast cancer was discovered through a routine mammogram — a screening that gave her a fighting chance. Regular screenings can detect cancer in its earliest stages, when it's most treatable and outcomes are often more favorable.

Understanding how overwhelming a cancer diagnosis can be, the team at UPMC Hillman Cancer Center works tirelessly to ensure patients aren't left waiting. **New patients are welcomed with immediate access to care**, enabling them to get answers, begin planning treatment, and feel supported from the very start.

More than Cancer: Treating a Range of Conditions

Since its inception, the Radiation Oncology team has been a lifeline for patients like Deborah. But their impact extends far beyond cancer care.

In addition to treating a wide range of cancers — including breast, lung, prostate, and brain tumors — the department also provides advanced therapies for certain noncancerous conditions such as benign tumors and thyroid disorders. Using technologies such as external beam radiation, brachytherapy, and radiosurgery, the team delivers precise, minimally invasive treatments that reduce side effects and improve outcomes.

"Our expertise extends to pain management and palliative support for advanced disease," explains Dr. Cousins. "And with new innovations emerging all the time, we'll be able to do even more — providing treatment with greater accuracy, speed, and comfort than ever before."

ichard "Dick" Lloyd is 91 years young. He and his late wife, Maralyn, have been a part of the Muncy community for five decades. In June 2023, Maralyn passed away after a long battle with cancer, at the age of 85. She was cherished by her family, friends, and neighbors, and Dick has ensured that her loving generosity and memory live on within the community she loved so much through the Maralyn Lloyd Endowment.

Remembering Maralyn

With Maralyn's beloved rescue cat, Harley, sleeping on his lap, Dick recalls how welcoming the people of Muncy were when his family first arrived. Many neighbors stopped in to introduce themselves, and it wasn't long before he and Maralyn became involved with the community. Maralyn embraced it all. "Muncy is our home, and it was the best move we ever made. The hospital was always a dominant part of the town, because it provided quality health care and jobs," says Dick. "We were always happy to volunteer and donate."

After graduating from Watertown High School in Watertown, N.Y., Maralyn went to Lycoming College in Williamsport, where she first met Dick. "It was love at first sight," remembers Dick. "My mother knew it, because she always used to say, 'Dickie must be in love

because we never see him anymore." By all accounts, Maralyn was equally smitten with him.

Dick and Maralyn were married in October 1959 in Canton, Pa., and they enjoyed 63 years together. Maralyn had a long and successful career in social work, which was a natural fit for her passion for helping others. She began her career with Children's Services in Wellsboro and continued to serve children at the Department of Children and Youth in Pike County. The family relocated and raised their two children, **Greg** and **Wendy**, in Muncy when a job opportunity presented itself for Dick with The Muncy Bank & Trust Company (now Journey Bank). Dick eventually became president of the bank, where he stayed until he retired.

In 1974, after the move to Muncy, Maralyn established a Social Service Department for Muncy Valley Hospital (now UPMC Muncy). She served as the department's director for 17 years. Later, she worked on a substitute basis at Jersey Shore and Williamsport hospitals, and then part-time for Kramm Nursing Home in Milton and the Williamsport Home.

After retiring, the couple volunteered at Muncy Valley Hospital's Same Day Surgery Department. This was a way for them to give back for all that the hospital teams had done for their community and their own family. Maralyn's mother had been to the emergency department many times as she got older, and the care she received there saved her life and improved the quality of her life. "The service they provided helped my family during very tough times, and I will never forget that," says Dick.

"The nurses and doctors are so nice and wonderful. My role was pushing patients in wheelchairs, delivering charts and supplies, and just doing whatever they needed," says Dick. Maralyn grew to know so many people at UPMC Muncy personally, as did he. "When Maralyn died, many of the doctors, nurses, and staff from the surgery center came to her funeral. It meant the world to me."

A Legacy of Love

The Lloyds' son, Greg, now lives in John Day, Ore., with his wife, **Robin**. Their daughter, Wendy Snyder, lives in Wellsboro with her husband, **Philip**. They, along with Wendy's two children, Brooke and Mitchell, all hold fond memories of how loving and community-conscious Maralyn was. Maralyn's positive impact has benefited them all. "She touched so many people's lives this way," recalls Dick.

Maralyn loved to be in the company of her friends and neighbors. Whether she was playing cards, entertaining at home, or participating in one of the many groups she belonged to, Maralyn connected with others. She was a member of the Muncy Business and Professional Women's Club and the West Branch Chorale. She served on the area's first Mothers Against Drunk Driving (MADD) committee and received a recognition award for her dedication to 4-H. Maralyn also served on the Messiah Lutheran Church council and the church's women's auxiliary.

Maralyn was a great listener and very passionate about helping and getting to know people. "She was a social worker at heart, and it showed," says Dick. After her passing, he wanted to create an endowment fund that did great things for the community and also fit Maralyn's true spirit.

"She was the best person I ever knew," Dick says of his late wife. "I established the Maralyn Lloyd Endowment fund because I don't want her to ever be forgotten. With this fund and the resources it will supply to the

community at UPMC Muncy, she will be remembered as someone who always found time and energy to help people. Because that's who she was."

Dick and Maralyn were generous supporters of the UPMC Muncy Emergency Department for many years. They made a major gift in 2013 in support of the facility's renovations and expansion. "We saw a need and asked how we could help. We donated to support the hospital and community we cared deeply about. It was an easy decision we happily made," says Dick.

The Maralyn Lloyd Endowment

In August 2024, the Maralyn Lloyd Endowment was established. "It is so important to have both a strong UPMC Muncy and a strong Susquehanna Health Foundation supporting it. We benefit greatly because they work together," says Dick. "The health care needs in our community are nonstop, so support must remain strong and vital."

Dick also feels strongly that his community is fortunate to have a great skilled nursing program at UPMC Muncy. The hospital has a 138-bed skilled nursing facility that provides medical and rehabilitative care to patients who need more intensive support than a nursing home or assisted living facility can usually offer. "Skilled nursing keeps us going, and we are very proud of UPMC Muncy and Muncy Place, as many generations here have benefited from this level of care," says Dick.

Dick knows that the Maralyn Lloyd Endowment will carry on the support and funding that the area needs in Maralyn's name. He is proud of this. "Maralyn made my life so great and wonderful, and now this is something I can do for her that I know she would have loved," he says. "I remember when I was really busy in my career and Maralyn always took care of me and our family, so that we could do our best. No one asked her to do it; she just knew it would help make things better." Now he is committed to keeping her spirit alive with this endowment in her name. "Even now, she continues to help make things better," he reflects.

"Now her kindness will always be her legacy."

INVESTING IN THE UNSEEN:

UPMC Williamsport's \$17-Million Lab Transformation

ost hospital visitors never see it, but inside the walls of UPMC Williamsport, the clinical laboratory is the engine behind thousands of medical decisions every day. Blood, urine, and tissue samples from across the region arrive at UPMC Williamsport for testing, helping doctors diagnose conditions, guide treatments, and save lives.

Now, after decades in its original footprint, this vital space is undergoing a once-in-a-generation, \$17-million transformation — an investment years in the making that will directly benefit patients and the community for decades to come.

"Our clinical laboratory supports all testing for UPMC Williamsport and much of the work for our entire region," says **Erica Grater**, administrative director, Laboratory

Services, UPMC in North Central Pa. "We're the hub for many specialized tests, so upgrading our space and equipment has a direct impact on patients across north central Pennsylvania."

The lab's original core dates back to 1972, with only minor cosmetic updates over the years. The current renovation spans 23,000 square feet and is being completed in seven carefully orchestrated phases to keep services running without interruption.

"It's like solving a giant sliding puzzle," says **Conner Oldt**, construction project manager, Construction Management, UPMC in North Central Pa. "We can't just shut the lab down, so we've strategically moved teams and equipment around while still delivering patient results every day."





Better Care, Faster Results

After years of extensive planning, construction began in March 2024. When finished in early 2027, the renovated lab will feature:

- A streamlined open layout with automation to speed the journey from sample to result.
- **New patient-friendly spaces** including a dedicated blood draw room, a convenient pick-up and drop-off window for specimens, and expanded storage areas to keep the lab running efficiently.
- **Shorter wait times** for critical lab results, allowing physicians to begin treatment sooner.
- **Expanded in-house testing**, reducing the need to send samples elsewhere and cutting down delays in diagnosis.
- Consistency with the larger UPMC system, thanks to standardized equipment and testing ranges, ensuring the same level of care locally as in Pittsburgh.

"This project gives us room to grow," Erica says. "We can offer more tests, work more efficiently, and ultimately give patients the answers they need faster — which can make all the difference in treatment and recovery."

A Boost for Recruitment and Education

The transformation is also expected to make UPMC Williamsport more attractive to medical laboratory professionals, a field facing a nationwide shortage.

The hospital leads educational programs — including a

Medical Laboratory Scientist program — to train the next generation of lab experts in a brand-new lab classroom.

"Having a modern, well-equipped space is a huge selling point," Erica says. "When prospective employees or students tour the lab, they see right away that this is a place investing in the future of health care."

The new design also builds in flexibility for future growth. Modular workstations and infrastructure upgrades mean the lab can adapt as technology advances without costly overhauls.

An Investment You Can't Always See — But Will Always Feel

For Conner, the project represents more than construction.

"A clean, modern lab sends a message," he says. "It tells patients, staff, and the community that this is a place where we're committed to providing cutting-edge health care — even in the parts of the hospital most people never see."

After years of planning and months of careful construction, staff say it's still surreal to walk into bright, state-of-the-art work areas after decades in the original space.

"We've waited a long time for this," Erica says. "This investment will not only serve our patients today but will help us attract the skilled professionals who will care for this community tomorrow."

A QCD allows you to donate directly from your IRA to Susquehanna Health Foundation without having to pay taxes on the distribution. Here's how it works:

- Eligibility: You must be $70\frac{1}{2}$ years of age or older.
- Tax Benefits: QCDs are not included in your taxable income, so they can help reduce your tax liability. Additionally, QCDs count toward your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) for the year.
- Annual Limit: You can donate up to \$108,000 per year from your IRA to qualified charities like the Foundation.
- **Direct Transfer Required:** The distribution must be made directly from your IRA to the Foundation in order to qualify for the tax benefits.



How to Make a QCD to the Foundation:

- Contact your IRA custodian to request a direct transfer of funds to Susquehanna Health Foundation personal checks made payable to the Foundation will not qualify.
- 2. Let the Foundation know your intention so we can ensure your gift is properly acknowledged and directed toward the area of your choice.

The Gatehouse

Through generous donor support, major renovations to this unique inpatient hospice unit help provide better palliative care and assistance.

ome may wonder how people can work in hospice care, where patients are at the end of their lives due to terminal disease or illness. But if you ask **Melody Roedts, BSN, RN, CHPN**, the clinical manager of hospice at The Gatehouse, an inpatient unit that is part of UPMC Home Healthcare of Central Pennsylvania, she would tell you that her job is incredibly meaningful and important. She takes great pride in what she and her Family Hospice teammates do every day.

"We help people through the process of dying so that they have comfort, dignity, and kindness. We support their families and caregivers as well," says Melody. "There is a real purpose to what we do."

About The Gatehouse

Situated on the UPMC Williamsport Divine Providence Campus, The Gatehouse is a peaceful, comforting place for short-term respite and relief for patients seeking end-of-life support and their families. This seven-bed inpatient hospice unit provides skilled medical and nursing care for the management of pain and other symptoms that cannot be managed safely or effectively in a home hospice setting or nursing facility. This can include symptoms such as nausea, vomiting, respiratory distress, seizures, and severe agitation.

"Our unit focuses on palliative care and relief so that, ideally, the patients can go back home," says Melody. While the goal is to improve symptoms so patients can return to where they were previously hospicing, sometimes they pass during their stay at The Gatehouse. "We are ready to handle those instances, if they should occur."

Whenever beds are available, The Gatehouse can also offer some patients respite stays. "These can last up to five days and help support family caregivers by giving them a little bit of a retreat or break," says Melody. When there is availability for a respite stay, the staff at The Gatehouse helps plan the visit to meet the patient's individual needs.

By providing a peaceful, home-like environment, The Gatehouse helps make an incredibly difficult time for patients and their loved ones a little bit easier. Families can spend quality time with patients in private bedroom suites, a comfortable family room, a kitchen, and a meditation room — all while patients receive around-the-clock, skilled nursing care to manage their difficult symptoms.

Over the last two decades, this vital inpatient center has served as a tranquil, private, and dignified space for hospice care. As the years went by, however, it became clear to the staff and others that The Gatehouse was due for a thoughtful, thorough, and much-needed makeover.

"Our volunteers are an essential part of The Gatehouse experience, and they offer incredible support to our patients, their families, and our staff," says Melody. "I don't know what we would do without them."

Post-COVID pandemic, Melody notes that there is a need for more volunteers at The Gatehouse and in Family Hospice. Whether it is by visiting with patients, honoring veterans, offering bereavement support, or providing nursing staff with assistance, hospice volunteers make a difference every day.

Volunteer opportunities include:

- Providing companionship to patients and respite assistance for families in their homes
- Visiting patients in The Gatehouse, or in skilled nursing or assisted living facilities
- Assisting staff at The Gatehouse with various tasks and programming
- Comforting patients near their last moments
- Honoring veteran patients with pinning ceremonies and vet-to-vet visits with the We Honor Veterans program
- Making scrapbooks, collecting stories on audio or video, or writing down memories for patients
- Playing comforting music for patients or becoming a Gatehouse Singer
- Helping provide bereavement support to families and loved ones

Melody notes that surviving family members are encouraged to wait a minimum of one year following the death of a loved one before serving as an active hospice volunteer.

There is also a volunteer program for making handmade quilts and blankets for hospice patients. This is a tradition at The Gatehouse that goes back many years. "In the 19 years I've been here, I have never seen them run out of quilts. It's amazing. We even have a beautiful one hanging up in our refurbished family room area," says Melody.

Major Renovations Have an Immediate Impact

Over the past two years, The Gatehouse facility was completely refreshed — from new furniture and décor to new playroom toys and an expansion of the existing Tree of Remembrance. Melody watched the facility be transformed, and the rejuvenated unit has been a real benefit for patients, their families, and The Gatehouse staff. There is a more home-like atmosphere now. Comforting details, such as warm colors, soothing artwork, and decorative pillows, can be found throughout the various rooms.

In addition to basic repairs and upgrades within the facility, the renovations included:

- Fully refurbished patient rooms with new beds, furniture, paint, and décor
- A remodeled kitchen families can now gather in to share meals
- Improved and modernized nursing stations
- A refurbished playroom with new toys for kids and families
- New information boards in the hallways
- · A staff break area and lockers
- A new family laundry area
- Spruced-up common areas for gathering
- An expanded Tree of Remembrance

"I love all the renovations, but the kids' play area has to be my favorite," says Melody. "It has a space-themed mural on the wall and lots to do. It's a happy space that everyone really enjoys having here, and a place where kids can just be kids."



The Tree of Remembrance Continues to Grow and Inspire

Including the Tree of Remembrance expansion in the renovations was important, because this artwork has been a meaningful part of the facility since The Gatehouse opened almost 20 years ago. By donating a leaf in the memory of their loved one, families and friends have a way to honor those who have passed while helping support others who will need The Gatehouse in the future.

Donations Keep The Gatehouse Open

Although The Gatehouse provides an important service, its expenses are greater than the income it generates. Thanks to generous contributions, the recent renovation project was completely donor-funded, keeping costs down for the community it serves.

"Next on our wish list is the replacement of our older CADD pain-medication pumps," says Melody. CADD is short for "computerized ambulatory delivery device," which is used in hospice care to deliver medication for pain management. This can be done continuously or on demand, either subcutaneously or intravenously. A CADD pump can enable patients to manage their pain more autonomously, and it can be used in a hospital or at home.

The hope is to have the new CADD pumps partly or fully funded by donations through the Susquehanna Health Foundation. "The Foundation has been really supportive and amazing, and they reach out several times a year to ask us what The Gatehouse needs," says Melody. "They truly understand what it is that we do in family hospice, and they have incredible compassion for our patients and their families."

Donations are critical to keeping The Gatehouse open and available to the entire community," says **Sherry Watts**, President of the Susquehanna Health Foundation. "In fact, we utilize up to \$100,000 annually to help cover the unreimbursed expenses that keep The Gatehouse running, because it is such a vital service to the UPMC in North Central Pa. community."

Sherry is always inspired by how donors continue to financially support the work of The Gatehouse. She is also inspired by the staff and volunteers. "The patients and families The Gatehouse serves every day have found so much comfort, support, and peace here. It's hard to put into words just how much that means to those in hospice."
