As Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital (SSMH) adapts to the ever-evolving field of healthcare through cutting-edge technology and procedures, it remains committed to its goal Soldiers + Sailors Memorial Hospital's Emergency Department currently treats more than 18,500 patients each year. Close to 3,000 of those patients are brought to the Emergency

When the previous Emergency Department began to exceed capacity with even larger increases in visits than forecasted, SSMH determined expansion was necessary. The hospital enhanced its facility through a two-story expansion housing new emergency and surgical care units-the largest

"It's also one of the most beautiful valleys—probably the best kept secret in the whole state."

Blaise moved his young family to Montoursville in 1980 when he Their gift is part of a family tradition of supporting organizations that help the overall well-being of the community. This past year, the Blaise Alexander Family Dealerships were a significant participant in *Raise the Region*, a campaign that successfully increased awareness of and contributions to local charities.

stage in my life. Giving to the community is very rewarding," says Blaise.

His community support over the years includes gifts through the Anne L. "Annie" and Blaise Robert "BR" Alexander Memorial Scholarship Fund as well as contributions of land and funds for the Eastern Lycoming YMCA in Muncy. His favorite charities also include those benefiting children and children with disabilities, such as the Children's Development Center and Hope Enterprises.

The Alexander family's connection to Susquehanna Health began when the late Anne "Annie" L. Alexander, Blaise's wife, and Adam's and Aubrey's mother, was a nurse at Williamsport Hospital during the 1980s. Later, when Annie was treated for cancer, Susquehanna Health was one of the places where she received care.

Blaise, who also formed connections with the health system through his

community involvement, says that a major inspiration for the Signature Gift is what Susquehanna Health has accomplished so far, as well as the organization's plans for the future.

"I am more than impressed with the leadership at Susquehanna Health. I have experience with big deals and projects, and what they are accomplishing is no small task," Blaise says. "When I bring potential



employees into town, I can show them around, and they see that while it's a rural area, the standard of living is outstanding. From the arts to the restaurants and colleges, we really have a lot to offer, and I think Susquehanna Health is the gem of the whole group.

"In a county that's bigger than the state of Rhode Island but with a population of just less than 120,000, you would never expect to find the medical facilities and level of care that we have," Blaise continues. "Everything they have talked about is coming to fruition. To do that takes courage; it's like building a new school or anything on a grand scale. It's a great project for our area and a great project for the next 100 years."

ROUTINE EXAM BYPASS

Ron Kennedy with his grandchildren Kendall, Connor and Hunter at Treasure Castle Playland in South Williamsport

ARRIVING AT WILLIAMSPORT REGIONAL MEDICAL CENTER at 7:30 am on October 1, 2013, **Ron Kennedy**, 66, of Montoursville planned to "knock out" his stress test before heading to work. The day took a decidedly different turn, resulting in Ron undergoing quadruple heart bypass surgery that afternoon.

He credits the quick action of staff and easy coordination of resources, doctors and surgeons from Susquehanna Health's Heart & Vascular Institute for his prompt, lifesaving treatment.

Ron was always athletic but says he's slowed down over the last nine years. Just over a year ago, Ron was diagnosed with diabetes. Despite his condition, he's stayed busy working, fishing, spending time with his six grandchildren and helping manage one of his grandson's baseball teams. Shortness of breath and a noticeable decrease in stamina sent him to his family doctor, who referred him for the stress test.

Ron struggled during the test and wasn't surprised when the administering nurse, **Sharon Heintzelman**, RN, called for cardiologist **Dr. Mohammad Shafique**. Within five minutes, Dr. Shafique arrived to check Ron's test results, which indicated insufficient blood flow to his heart. Dr. Shafique alerted interventional cardiologist **Dr. Donald Nardone**, who was ready to meet Ron in the Cardiac Catheterization Lab by 9 am.

During the diagnostic catheterization, Dr. Nardone discovered that one of Ron's arteries was 100 percent blocked and the other three were 66 percent blocked. Consulting with **Dr. Mark Osevala**, a cardiothoracic surgeon, they determined Ron needed quadruple bypass surgery. Dr. Nardone placed a balloon pump near Ron's heart to help it beat more efficiently while Dr. Osevala's team prepared for surgery. By 1 pm, the lifesaving bypass procedure had begun.

> "With the severity of his blockages, he was certainly at risk for a very severe or life-threatening cardiac event," Dr. Osevala says. "While this isn't the typical progression for a patient receiving a stress test, we are certainly equipped and ready to mobilize to provide seamless care in these high-risk situations."

> > While Ron's plans for the day changed rapidly, he says he was totally at ease with the quality of care he was receiving and was even pleased to see some familiar faces among his caregivers. "I had the best care Williamsport Regional Medical Center had to offer," says Ron. "I was totally blessed the whole way through."

As Ron recovered in his hospital room, with his son and daughter by his side, he was continually impressed by the doctors, nurses and staff who were providing his care.

"It just blew me away. The knowledge and competence of the nurses and staff were so great. I can't emphasize enough how well we were all treated," Ron says.

"The level of training, from charge nurse to the care at the bedside, is really the key to our success," Dr. Osevala says. "Our patients and their families derive a degree of comfort from their interactions with physicians, nurses, support staff, physical and respiratory therapists, and dietary and custodial staff. That friendly, professional manner is what sets us apart and allows patients and families to feel that they have been taken care of in a good, sincere manner. That's what we do here."

Ron was discharged six days after surgery, and about six weeks later he began participating in CHAMPS, Susquehanna Health's outpatient cardiac rehabilitation program. At CHAMPS, he exercised under the supervision of cardiac nurses who monitored his blood pressure and blood sugar levels. He also learned about lifestyle modifications he could make to ensure a safe return to an active lifestyle.

"We have an excellent, comprehensive continuum of care that allows us to meet the medical, physical, emotional and social needs of our patients, both immediately, postoperatively and continuing through to their recovery," Dr. Osevala says. "That way they can get back to their lives as quickly and completely as possible."

Back at work and spending plenty of time with his grandchildren, Ron is feeling better than he has in a long time.

"The exercise is definitely something I want to keep up with. I had been so dormant, so it's taking some time to regain strength," Ron says. "But I feel like I'm 50 again. People tell me I look great, and I feel better than I look!"

Apple TV and iPads Engage Rehabilitation Patients for Therapy n inpatient Rehabilitation at Williamsport Regional Medical Center, therapists are using iPads and Apple TV to help patients regain important skills from speech to hand-eye coordination and even moving from place to place.

About three years ago, speech therapists began bringing their personal iPads into work so patients could use applications designed to help with rehabilitation. Even patients who balked at picking up pencil and paper responded to the visuals and graphics on the iPad screen. Therapists noted that patients were more motivated to complete their treatments and there was a multitude of applications designed to assist with assessing and rehabilitating cognitive and fine motor skills.

Rehabilitation patients, who could be staying in the hospital up to six weeks depending on their diagnosis, also enjoyed the opportunity to engage in some of their typical activities like emailing to stay in contact with family and friends. Soon recreational therapists were bringing their iPads to use with patients, too. "We realized this engaging, colorful tool was helping patients get positively focused and enjoying therapy more," explains **Mary Ann Bellfy**, CTRS, Supervisor, Rehabilitation Services. "But we needed to have our own equipment to ensure the safety and security of our patients and staff."

Using funds from contributors like you, the Foundation donated four iPads, Apple TV, a 32-inch monitor and a cart for transport to aid with rehabilitation. Applications on the iPads assist therapists with evaluating patients, discovering deficit areas and introducing tools that can help them build certain skills.

"As an example, we have a game that helps stroke patients who have visual impairment work on their tracking skills by reminding them to look to the left or right," Mary Ann says.

The 32-inch monitor and Apple TV travel on a cart from one treatment area to another where physical therapists can record, using the iPad, and immediately show patients how to improve techniques or download videos to assist with teaching certain skills.

"It's a great teaching aid that really helps us personalize each rehabilitation experience," Mary Ann says. "A patient, who is tetraplegic, learned how to pull himself up to move from one location to another by watching a video of that skill broadcast on the monitor. As he worked on the technique, we videotaped him and showed him the tape so he could see his progress until he mastered the skill."

Their donation inspired the Cancer Center to use additional contributions to purchase SiriusXM Satellite Radios for their patients. Patients now can enjoy the soothing and healing qualities of music, which research shows can reduce anxiety and help the body produce antibodies to enhance immunity. Treatment chairs in the Cancer Center include SiriusXM Satellite Radio controllers and headsets so patients can tune into programming they enjoy.



"From the wall colors to the pictures and treatment chairs, we do whatever we can to create an environment that is calm, comfortable and healing," says **Michelle Gaida**, Executive Director of Cancer Services. "We take our cues from the patients, learning from them what makes the experience better. Music therapy is one of the many amenities we've been able to add with the very generous contributions from donors."

Other comfort items added with donations over the years include custom gowns and robes for radiation oncology patients, warming blankets, visual therapy in the radiation oncology treatment rooms, free hand massages, recliner chairs with heat and massage features, and the beautifully maintained three-tier healing garden.






