Keeping At-Risk Newborns Close to Home for Many Parents

The Birthplace™ at the Williamsport Regional Medical Center has expanded its Level II (Special Care) Nursery. This expansion allows even more families the comfort and peace of mind of staying in our community for the care of high-risk newborns.

The Birthplace™ has a specially trained Level II medical staff with board certified pediatricians: **Dr. Russell Gombosi,**

Dr. Qasim Mahmood, Dr. Thomas Martin and Dr. William Pagana and nurses. They care for premature infants born at 32 weeks or older and full-term babies with medical conditions such as the need for special respiratory care, administration of medications and fluids intravenously and/or the use of special lights for babies with jaundice, a condition common to premature babies.

Keeping At-Risk Newborns Close to Home for Many Parents

For one local couple, not only did they experience the advanced Level II medical care provided by the specially trained pediatricians and nurses but also the compassion and care with which it was delivered. The couple came to Susquehanna Health to deliver their child. The mother was a little more

than his personal cell phone number, but he also came to see them at the other hospital on his own time.

Because of their relationship with Susquehanna Health and the proximity of the facility, the family really wanted to have their new baby transferred back

there. Parents can stay and sleep on-site at the Hospitality Inn at no charge while their baby is being cared for. In addition to staying at the Hospitality Inn, the mother was able to sleep right in The Birthplace™ to have better access to breastfeed and share special bonding time with her baby. The mother was also very pleased with the meal service. The service allows you to have exactly what you want, whenever you want, just as you like it.

"I enjoyed watching the young resident physicians benefit and learn from Dr. Martin's expertise," says the mother. "The residents appeared so eager to gain knowledge from him."

"Dr. Martin is so energetic, he never stays still," adds the father. "I believe it is because he is so dedicated to caring for his patients, he doesn't want to take the time to stop." Both parents agreed it is evident he loves what he does.

"Dr. Martin is open to suggestions, willing to listen to his patients' needs and make things work to their advantage," comments **James Huebert**, Susquehanna Health's Manager of Social Services. "I have seen many examples of Dr. Martin going way beyond the call of duty to help his patients any time day or night—he truly provides family-centered care."

After spending four days at Williamsport Regional Medical Center, their healthy baby was able to go home with the family. According to the mother, "Our baby has adjusted very well to being home."

Premature infants, those born at 32 to 36 weeks, often require special care. Sometimes this care means that the baby's stay at the hospital can be up to a month, while their mothers are usually discharged after a brief hospital stay. Studies show that family involvement in the baby's care improves the baby's outcome and shortens the hospital stay.

than 31 weeks along in the pregnancy and was experiencing some serious medical complications, putting her life and her unborn baby's life in jeopardy.

After initially arriving at The Birthplace™ at the Williamsport Regional Medical Center, it was determined that the mother would need to be transferred to another area medical facility for her care. Although the couple was reluctant at first to go to the other facility, they agreed to travel by ambulance there for the birth of their child. After being at the other hospital for three days, their baby was born weighing just 4 pounds, 11 ounces.

After being born, their baby stayed in the hospital out of town for six days. The family was very surprised and pleased that Dr. Martin not only gave

to Williamsport Regional Medical Center for care and reached out to Dr. Martin for assistance in making it happen.

Dr. Martin and the ambulance crew went above and beyond to help the family. Dr. Martin made arrangements and traveled with the ambulance on a Sunday to transfer the baby back to Williamsport. He also made arrangements for the couple and their luggage to travel on the ambulance. This was a huge help to the family, who would otherwise have had to hire a driver to transport them. They were also very grateful for all the help the ambulance crew gave them, even helping to load their luggage.

Once back at Williamsport Regional Medical Center, the couple continued to be impressed by the experiences

a more resident- and family-focused setting with a home-like atmosphere and more space for visiting and activities. Other features include a new dining area and a private room for family celebrations.

The second floor will feature an expanded state-of-the-art center for physical medicine and rehabilitation to meet growing demands and offer increased privacy and enhanced services. A larger therapy gym, kitchenette and living room will allow individuals to simulate skills needed at home to prepare for discharge from the facility. The bright, modern space provides outdoor views to promote healing.

"We're seeing an increase in these services both due to the aging population as well as more people choosing our facility for their care," says hospital administrator **Chris Ballard**, noting that the hospital's lobby and main entrance will also get a facelift.



Williamsport Regional Medical Center's New Patient Tower



Construction of a modern, four-story patient tower is underway at the Williamsport Regional Medical Center. With the steel beam framework complete, work this summer is focused on construction of exterior walls. The goal is to have the building sealed by early November. The new tower features an improved healing environment for patients with spacious, private, "hotel-like" rooms with space dedicated for families. At ground level the tower will house the expanded Emergency department and Imaging Services. An Education and Innovation Center will be located on the second floor in

addition to space for future growth for patient services. Five new surgical suites and a sterile preparation area are included on the third floor, with space for future growth. The top of the tower includes a 24-bed medical/surgical unit specializing in the care and recovery of orthopedic patients and a 28-bed unit for patients who require additional monitoring.

Williamsport Regional Medical Center Receives More Recognition for Excellence

Williamsport Regional Medical Center (WRMC) has been named a Blue Distinction Center for excellence in three areas: spine surgery, knee and hip replacement and cardiac care.

The recognition is awarded by Blue Cross of Northeastern Pennsylvania to healthcare facilities “that meet objective, evidence-based thresholds for clinical quality.” Simply put, that means WRMC’s medical care programs are among the best in the country.

High Level of Quality

“Earning Blue Distinction is quite an honor,” says **Lori Beucler**, Administrative Director, Perioperative Services. “This designation speaks to the outstanding caliber of our orthopedic and neurosurgeons and our designated teams of specialized professionals.”

But it goes beyond bragging rights. “In order to achieve this designation, a hospital must deliver a high level of quality and patient outcomes,” Beucler continues. “Among other things, that means a low readmission rate and a low post-operative infection rate.”

WRMC continuously strives to meet high internal benchmarks for quality. “When these are recognized by a trusted independent third party like Blue Cross and Blue Shield, it reaffirms our commitment to quality,” Beucler adds.

Beneficial Process

Earning Blue Distinction status required completing a comprehensive application. Beucler says it was a valuable exercise that helped focus attention on best practices.

“We were able to demonstrate excellent results in our quality initiatives by participating in the national quality programs and developing our own clinical dashboards—a series of benchmarks that tell us how well our patients are doing compared with national and regional norms,” she says.

The application required proof of excellence from pre-admission through discharge and beyond. That includes everything from surgery performance and admission practices to in-hospital care, patient education, collaboration among doctors and nurses, and post-discharge services, such as rehabilitation and home care.

Blue Distinction helps hospitals know where they stand, but it also helps patients make informed decisions about their own care.

Honoring Women with **Courage**

Just completing its ninth year, the Kathryn Candor Lundy Breast Health Center Women's Golf Tournament and Fund Drive raised more than \$53,000 to enhance services of the Breast Health Center.

The three-month fund drive ended in June with an all-female tournament at the Williamsport Country Club. Proceeds will be used to purchase the most diagnostically advanced digital viewing tools to aid the Center's physicians with accurate and efficient diagnosis of breast cancer in its earliest, most curable stage.

The event, which drew 116 golfers for a two-person scramble, also honors the women who have dealt with breast cancer and who now provide support to other women and their families as they go through survivorship. Speaking at the event, breast cancer survivor **Linda Dunkle** described her experiences at the Breast Health Center and urged all women to take time for their health. A long-delayed mammogram led her to the Center and the detection of her

aggressive form of breast cancer at an early stage. The 51-year-old real estate agent was caring for her husband, Neil, who was recovering from surgery to treat esophageal cancer, when she received her diagnosis and recalls thinking, "How much time will this take?"

To her relief, her care was swift, thorough and of the same caliber that her husband received at a larger medical center more than two hours away from Williamsport. She credits efficient diagnostic tools and rapid treatment, including the surgical skills of **Dr. Timothy Pagana**, with saving her life. Daily radiation treatments that were just 20 minutes from home, consistent care from a radiation oncologist and the same physician-nurse team at the Breast Health Center as well as amazing resources and supportive staff helped her on her journey to become a breast cancer survivor.

Continued support of the Breast Health Center makes stories like Linda's possible. Over the years, more than \$350,000 has been raised for the Center through the annual golf tournament and fund drive, which receives contributions and sponsorships from individuals, local businesses and community groups.

Dr. Frederic G. Sanford

The Sanford family's ties to the Lycoming County medical community are deep.

Dr. Frederic G. Sanford recalls that his father and grandfather, both physicians, owned the Sanford Private Hospital in Jersey Shore, which later became part of Jersey Shore Hospital. After his grandfather's death in the mid-1930s, Frederic's father, the late **Dr. Frederic E. Sanford**, became a general surgeon and served in World War II before settling his young family in Williamsport in the early 1940s. He practiced at Jersey Shore Hospital, Divine Providence Hospital and The Williamsport Hospital before retiring in the early 1980s.

In memory of his father's longtime service to the medical community and that of his mother, the late **Martha Jane Sanford**, to the hospital auxiliaries,

Dr. Sanford made a Cornerstone contribution to Susquehanna Health.

"My father worked with an extremely congenial group of physicians throughout his time in Williamsport. He seemed to thrive on the professional relationships he had," explains Dr. Sanford, a retired rear admiral who spent the majority of his medical career in the U. S. Navy Medical Department as a radiologist with a subspecialty in radiation oncology. "I obtained a very positive attitude about medicine and organized medicine through his experiences and wanted to honor his affiliation with that wonderful group of physicians and nurses in Williamsport."

Dr. Sanford has kept informed about the developments in Lycoming County medicine over the years because of his

father's role in its history and family ties to both the Jersey Shore and Williamsport areas. Though his military career took him away from the area, Dr. Sanford was married to the girl who lived next door to his childhood home in Williamsport, **Mary Jane Sharpless**, for 30 years until her death in 2002, and he returns to the area regularly to visit relatives. Now serving on several boards and committees related to federal healthcare, the former executive director of the Association of Military Surgeons of the United States appreciates the significance of Project 2012.

"I think it's important to bring all of the advances in medicine into the valley and draw in new medical practitioners. It was very logical to give a gift that would honor my mother and father and support that development," he says.

Dr. and Mrs. Ted Larson Jr.

"We are all so fortunate to have just about any type of healthcare we need right here in the community because of Susquehanna Health," says retired radiologist **Dr. Ted Larson Jr.** He and his wife, **Jane**, made a \$25,000 contribution to the *Count On Us For Life* Capital Campaign.

"Because Jane and I have received so much through the hospitals, our church and community, we wanted to say 'thank you' in a way that helps keep it going for the next generation," Dr. Larson explains.

Born and raised in Williamsport, Dr. Larson and Jane first met in Sunday school class at St. Mark's Lutheran Church, the church they still attend, when he was six and she was four. Romance bloomed much later, and they married

nearly 53 years ago during the final year of his residency at Temple University School of Medicine in Philadelphia.

After Dr. Larson completed his military service in 1964, the couple returned to Williamsport, where he joined West Branch Radiologist Group. Jane, a registered nurse, was employed by Divine Providence Hospital during Dr. Larson's internship at The Williamsport Hospital. She also volunteered in the medical clinic at The Williamsport Hospital through the Junior League. Over the years, Dr. Larson served as secretary to the Medical Society, on the board of the West Branch Drug and Alcohol Commission and as president of the Williamsport Division of the American Cancer Society.

As part of the radiology group that created the area's first MRI center,

provided the first CAT scan equipment, and developed the first cancer treatment center with a cobalt source, Dr. Larson appreciates and supports Susquehanna Health's focus on incorporating new technology to enhance medical care through Project 2012.

GRATEFUL PATIENT SPOTLIGHT

Gloria Currie

While vacationing at her summer home in Eagles Mere last year, Gloria Currie became extremely ill. Although in a great deal of pain and barely able to move, she managed to call her daughter, **Jean**, who quickly drove from her home outside of Philadelphia to be with her.

Jean knew her mother needed medical care. Unfamiliar with the area's healthcare providers, she took the recommendation of a vacationing pulmonary surgeon, who suggested Muncy Valley Hospital because of his father-in-law's experience there. When Currie arrived at Muncy Valley Hospital via ambulance, doctors initially thought she was dehydrated but quickly determined that she had fluid

in her lungs and around her heart. The fluid was tested, and she was transferred to Williamsport Regional Medical Center for surgery to eliminate it.

"I had an extremely skilled surgeon. All of the doctors and nurses were very capable, and I received wonderful treatment. I'm so lucky," says Currie, noting her only previous hospitalizations were for the births of her sons, **Teddy** and **John**, and her daughter.

While her children hoped she would transfer to one of the large, urban hospitals near her home in St. David's, Pennsylvania, Gloria stayed in Williamsport.

"It's a nice, small, more intimate setting where the staff really take pride in what

they are doing," she says. "There was an overall feeling of security among the patients that I met during my recovery."

Following her surgery she returned to Muncy Valley Hospital for nearly five weeks of recovery, including physical and occupational therapy.

"The therapists were wonderful. They pushed me, but not too hard," says Currie, who is doing fine now. "I was very content and comfortable with the level of care at both hospitals. I ended up at the right place at the right time, and I'm grateful to the kind, patient and very helpful doctors and staff who took care of me."
